"We are on the verge of finishing our first ever contract. In the future, this places an increased cost when we are advocating for ourselves. In the past, we've received assistance from the CPFF when we've needed to pass a local ballot question to secure funding for our Fire District." Said Brantley. "The donation from the DFDFCU will help us to achieve a better financial position for future negotiations and possibly political actions."
